

Certificate IV in Building & Construction (Building)

The principal aim of the Higher Level Skills Program is to help individuals gain the higher level skills required to secure employment or career advancement.

Courses Available (Queensland Government Funded)

*Student Contribution Fees apply to all students partaking in the Higher Level Skills program, however fees are not payable for credit transfers.

Concessional Participants are defined as follows:

- the Participant holds a Health Care concession card or Pensioner concession card issued under Commonwealth law, or is the partner or a dependant of a person who holds a Health Care concession card or Pensioner concession card, and is named on the card; or
- the Participant can provide an official form under Commonwealth law confirming that the Participant, his or her partner or the person of whom the Participant is a dependant, is entitled to concessions under a Health Care or Pensioner concession card; or
- the Participant is an Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander person.
- the Participant has a disability
- the Participant is an adult prisoner.

Are you eligible?

To be eligible for the Higher Level Skills Program a participant must:

- be 15 years of age or older, and no longer at school
- permanently reside in Queensland
- be an Australian citizen, Australian permanent resident, temporary resident on the pathway to permanent residency or a New Zealand citizen (proof will be required)
- not hold, or be enrolled in a certificate IV or higher qualification
- hold a Certificate III construction trade qualification.

Acceptance is subject to eligibility criteria and availability.

Other Requirements

Participants will no longer be eligible for further subsidised training under the Program once they complete the Certificate IV Qualification.

Participants will be required to complete the Training and Employment Survey within three months after training.

Delivery Mode

Workplace/Onsite (South-East QLD) – travel fees may apply for remote/regional areas.

Blended delivery – combination of us coming to you and classroom delivery.

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) – we recognise the skills you have and train you in the skills you need.

Course duration – 1 to 6 months, depending on RPL

Support Services

Clients who have been identified with barriers to learning will be supported with the agreed appropriate strategies to accommodate their learning styles and/or abilities.

The range of possible actions for support include, but are not limited to:

- referral to English Language Support or literacy and/or numeracy courses
- referral for individual personal, financial or academic counselling
- individual or small group tutorial support
- individual or small group study plans
- provision of additional resources, including but not limited to video/DVDs, online learning
- alternative texts, workbooks and/or assessments
- provision of workshops on particular topics.
