Smart and Skilled - NSW ³	\$2,000 Apprentice \$1,000 Trainees	Apprentice/trainees are required to pay the fee over the term of the apprenticeship/traineeship.
Career Start - QLD	\$1.60 per nominal hour	All apprentices are required by DTET to contribute towards the cost of their training. The tuition fee is calculated at a set rate per nominal hour for each unit of competency. Total fees will vary according to units selected in the training plan and are payable on commencement of units. ⁴

¹ As per Gimbal Training Fees & Refund Policy more than \$1,500 in pre-paid fees cannot be collected on enrolment for any course.

Queensland – Career Start

Student contribution fees are based on \$1.60 per nominal hour for each unit of competency, as set by the Queensland Government. The total cost may vary based on unit selection (see information under qualification). Student tuition fees are indicative only and are subject to change given individual circumstances at enrolment. Partial and full fee exemptions apply for concession students, Year 12 Graduates in high priority qualifications, and other categories of students, subject to evidence of eligibility. This training is delivered with Queensland Government funding.
