

Apprentice Student Contribution Fees

Student Contribution Fees are calculated at a fixed rate set by the Department of Trade, Employment and Training (DTET) annually. All registered training organisations are to charge the same rate of \$1.60 per nominal hour. The nominal hours assigned to each competency are listed below, total fees will vary according to units selected in the training plan and are payable on commencement of units.

The Free apprenticeships for under 25s initiative will cover the cost of training for Queensland apprentices who commenced or undertaking a high priority apprenticeship from 1 January 2021 to 30 June 2027.

Concession fees

Students over 25 years of age that fall into one of the following categories will receive a concession and only be required to pay 40%:

- The student holds a Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession Card.
- The student is an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander.
